PLAN OF ACTION



Increasing Math Skills

As a school – We will offer after-school tutoring for students who are struggling in the area of math, and offer research-based programs to supplement classroom instruction. Also, the school will provide after-school computer access for students as needed.

As a parent – I will stay informed of my child’s progress in Math and provide transportation at least once a week for after-school tutoring.

As a student – I will commit to attending after-school tutoring when I am struggling in my Math class, and will communicate with my parent and teacher when I need additional help.

Increasing Writing Skills

As a school – We will provide research-based writing instruction in the classroom and offer detailed feedback to help facilitate the revision process for students, provide parents with quarterly updates on specific writing growth, and provide after-school tutoring in the area of ELA.

As a parent – I will monitor my child’s growth in writing, provide transportation to after-school tutoring, and provide feedback on progress reports and grades.

As a student – Using the feedback my teacher provides, I will work with my teacher and parents to revise my assigned essays and attend after-school tutoring when I am struggling in my class.

Increasing Reading Skills

As a school – We will provide specific research-based reading strategies for all students in all content areas, administer reading assessments and use data to guide our instruction, and offer after- school tutoring in the area of writing.

As a parent – I will make reading a priority and monitor internet time and limit usage if necessary, and provide transportation to after-school tutoring.

As a student – I will make reading a routine and learn ways to strengthen my reading skills.
